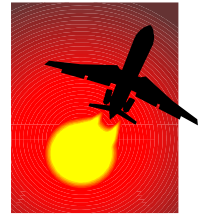

A job well done by the crew at Avwright Aviation Professionals.

A local business, started by Mr Jai Wright at Yarrawonga aerodrome, has been awarded a contract for refurbishment of a number of million dollar aircraft.

Mr Wright said that his business has grown since he moved back to Yarrawonga and he has gathered a team of highly skilled workers to cope with the many and varied challenges that come within the aviation industry.

The million dollar Cessna Caravan aircraft had to be stripped of all its paint, the engine and airframe had to be inspected thoroughly, along with numerous sheet metal repairs, before being reassembled. Mr Wright also said that the painting of this aircraft was originally awarded to a company in Melbourne, but that he had pushed very hard and won the whole job, from start to completion to be done at Yarrawonga.

Mr Wright sub-contracted the painting to another business on the aerodrome, Douglas Aviation.

Yesterday, the 11<sup>th</sup> of October 2007, the owner of the aircraft flew to Yarrawonga in a second aircraft to be worked on by Avwright, and by the look on his face, he was a very happy man .... Happy with the mammoth task of maintenance and makeover achieved on his newest acquisition. This one job injected over \$50,000 into the Yarrawonga economy.

The aircraft departed yesterday afternoon after a thorough flight check and the Ok being given by the Avwright team. Mr Wright said it was a big job, but that his team was very professional about the work and every rivet, and bolt had been checked
